We will take all steps to minimise any impact on you, however there will be some machinery noise, temporary restrictions to parking and alternate pedestrian access.

In the event of wet weather, the City's contractor will try to start the work the following day. If unsuitable weather continues, we will notify you of a change in scheduling.

Access to properties in the street will remain and we will contact you if we need to restrict access to progress part of the works.

Please note that the safety of our community, customers, staff and contractors, is our top priority. Rescheduling of works at short notice because of the current Covid-19 global pandemic may be required.
