## STREET IMPROVEMENTS – INTERSECTION OF WOOLLEY STREET AND WOOLLEY LANE, GLEBE

We will soon start work to improve the intersection of Woolley Street and Woolley Lane, Glebe. These works will increase pedestrian, bike and public transport access while improving safety and greening our streets.

Street: Woolley Street

**Intersection:** Woolley Lane

**Type of work:** Raised pedestrian crossing, concrete footpath, garden beds, tactile

installation and linemarking

Start date: 1 December 2021

**Duration:** Three weeks

**Working hours:** 7.30am to 5.30pm – Monday to Friday

7.30am to 3.30pm - Saturday

We will work to minimise impacts during this time. However, there may be machinery noise, temporary restrictions to traffic parking and changes to pedestrian access.

If there is bad weather, our contractors will try to start the work the next day. If unsuitable weather continues, we will update you on any changes to the schedule.

You will still be able to access properties in the street. We will contact you if we need to temporarily restrict access to progress work.

Please note that works maybe rescheduled at short notice because of the current Covid-19 global pandemic. The safety of our communities, customers and staff is our top priority.
