**NOTICE – NIGHT WORKS ON DEVONSHIRE STREET  
BETWEEN CHALMERS STREET AND ELIZABETH STREET  
George Street South Pedestrianisation**

We are working on behalf of the City of Sydney to extend the pedestrian boulevard on George Street to Rawson Place and create a new public space on Devonshire Street, between Chalmers Street and Elizabeth Street. Works on George Street are well underway, and we plan to start work on Devonshire Street early next year.

As part of these works, we will be doing some early investigation and service location works on Devonshire Street later this month.

These works are required to be done at night, to manage safety requirements of working adjacent to the light rail tracks.

**Works Location:** Devonshire Street, between Elizabeth Street and Chalmers Street

**Construction Works:** Potholing

**Start Date:** Monday 22 November to Thursday 25 November 2021

**Duration:** Four (4) nights, weather permitting

**Working hours:** 8pm to 3am

Sydney Civil will work to minimise impacts during this time. However, there may be some machinery noise as well as temporary disruptions to pedestrian traffic. Access to all properties will be maintained at all times.

We will continue to keep you updated about the new public space on Devonshire Street, which will include wider footpaths, more greenery, new lighting and street furniture.

Further notifications and dates will be provided prior to the commencement of construction.
