**NOTICE – WEEKEND WORKS (23 - 26 JULY 2021) & COMMENCEMENT OF NEW STAGE
George Street South Pedestrianisation**

We are working on behalf of the City of Sydney to convert the southern end of George Street to a pedestrian boulevard. As part of this project, work on George Street, between Bathurst Street and Rawson Place, has been programmed over the weekend from Friday 23 July to Monday 26 July 2021.

This weekend work will occur when the light rail is not operating due to planned maintenance by Transport for NSW, and will allow us to work next to the track slab. We will work continuously over the weekend to complete this critical stage of work in a reduced timeframe, and lessen the overall impact on the community.

Once the weekend works are completed, the section of George Street between Bathurst Street and Goulburn Street will be largely complete, and we will commence construction of the next stage of the project – the eastern side of George Street, between Goulburn Street and Hay Street. Construction will continue in stages to reduce impacts on the community. Notifications will be sent before work starts in a new area.

Location: George Street, between Bathurst Street & Rawson Place

Construction Works: Creating a pedestrian boulevard with new paving, trees and street furniture

Construction Work Details:

- 1) George Street, between Bathurst Street and Rawson Place (Eastern and Western side) – Continuous works (24/7) from 23 July at 9.00pm to 26 July at 4.00am 2021.
- 2) Commencement of new stage on George Street, between Goulburn Street and Hay Street (Eastern side) from 26 July 2021 with an approximate duration of 12 weeks (weather permitting).

Working hours for 23 to 26 July works: 24/7 (between the above dates and times)

Working hours for the Stage on George Street from Goulburn Street to Rawson Place (East side): 7am to 5pm (Monday to Saturday). There may be some minor night and weekend works to meet various authorities' approval requirements.

Sydney Civil will work to minimise impacts during this time. However, there may be machinery noise as well as temporary disruptions to local and pedestrian traffic. Access to all properties will be maintained at all times.

Thank you for your patience while we deliver this important piece of infrastructure upgrade to the area, which will enhance the appearance of the public domain.
