Improving Macleay Street

Work will start on the Macleay Street upgrade in mid-September, initially between Orwell Street and Challis Avenue. Staff have had conversations with businesses about ways to reduce disruption.

The improvements will make the area safer for people walking, help calm traffic, and improve the streetscape with more trees and plants.

Street:	Macleay Street
Section:	Orwell Street to Challis Avenue
Type of work:	Paving, continuous footpath treatments, street lighting, trees, garden beds, street furniture, raised intersection at Greenknowe Avenue and in-lane bus stops
Timing:	14 September 2020 – service investigation works start 6 October 2020 – project starts
Duration:	18 months
Working hours:	7.30am to 5.30pm – Monday to Friday 7.30am to 3.30pm – Saturday

We will work to minimise impacts during this time. However, there may be machinery noise, temporary restrictions to traffic parking and changes to pedestrian access.

If there is bad weather, our contractors will try to start the work the next day. If unsuitable weather continues, we will update you on any changes to the schedule.

You will still be able to access properties in the street. We will contact you if we need to temporarily restrict access to progress work.

The safety of our communities, residents and staff is our top priority. Because of the Covid-19 pandemic, it may become necessary to reschedule works at short notice.

Thank you for your patience while we complete these important works.


