

George Street South Pedestrianisation Project, Sydney



PROJECT UPDATE – SEPTEMBER 2021

Works completed

- Mid-block areas are open for pedestrians between Bathurst Street and Goulburn Street.
- The area west of the light rail tracks between Liverpool Street and Goulburn Street will open early September 2021.
- Pedestrian fences will be removed once approval from relevant Authorities is obtained. This is expected around mid to late September 2021.

Current and upcoming works for September

- Ongoing intersection works along George Street at Bathurst Street, Liverpool Street and Goulburn Street.
- Pits, cleaning and sealing of pavements and furniture installation works on George Street between Bathurst Street and Goulburn Street.
- Continuing works on the east side of George Street between Goulburn Street and Hay Street, including stormwater, paving and concreting.
- Work on the east side of George Street between Hay Street and Rawson Place has begun, including excavation and utilities conflicts' resolution, stormwater and concreting.
- Work on the west side of George Street between Goulburn St and Hay St is planned to started around mid-September 2021.

Working hours

- Day works: Monday to Saturday 7am to 5pm.
- Night works: Some night works may be required. Separate notifications will be distributed.

We will take steps to minimise impacts on local business owners and residents, however please note there may be machinery noise as well as temporary disruptions to local and pedestrian traffic. Access to all properties will be maintained at all times.
