

George Street South Pedestrianisation Project, Sydney



PROJECT UPDATE – JANUARY 2022

Works Completed

- Areas are open for pedestrian access across the light rail tracks on George Street between Bathurst Street and Hay Street.
- The section between Hay Street and Rawson Place is now open on the east side.

Current and Upcoming Works

- Works are continuing between Ultimo Road and Rawson Place on the west side, including stormwater, concreting, pit installation and paving.
- Extending the cycleway in Liverpool Street to the intersection at George Street.
- Construction to start in new areas:
 - Devonshire Street between Chalmers Street and Elizabeth Street to begin mid-February.
 - Hay Street between George Street and Sussex Street to begin mid-February.

Weekend Works 12-14 February 2022

Continuous weekend works have been scheduled from 12-14 February during a programmed Light Rail shut-down, including:

- Paving at the intersections of George Street at Bathurst Street, Liverpool Street, and Goulburn Street.
- Installing tactile pavers abutting the track slab south of Hay Street.
- Works abutting the track slab on Devonshire Street between Elizabeth Street and Chalmers Street

Working Hours

- Day works: Monday to Saturday 7am to 5pm.
- Some night works may be required; separate notifications will be distributed.
