IMPROVING TRAFFIC AND SAFETY IN WOLLI CREEK - CONSTRUCTION **UPDATE (MAY 2020)**

Bayside Council is working to improve traffic flow and safety for road users, pedestrians and cyclists in Wolli Creek.

In January, Sydney Civil was engaged to implement the one way circuit chosen by the community, plus other improvements. These will include increased street lighting, widening and beautification of footpaths and roads, extra pedestrian crossings, adding a bicycle lane and addressing storm water issues to fix localised flooding.

Update of work status:

Progress works for May:

- Commence road reconstruction on the North side of Arncliffe Street.
- Commence footpath upgrade along Guess Avenue.
- Commence storm water works on Guess Avenue.
- Commence footpath upgrade on Mount Olympus Blvd.
- Completed Kerb and Gutter reconstruction on Guess Avenue
- Completed Kerb and Gutter reconstruction on Mount Olympus Blvd.

Program of works for June:

- Continue drainage works on Guess Avenue.
- Commence road reconstruction on Guess Avenue
- Continue storm water upgrade, kerb and gutter and footpath reconstruction on Arncliffe Street (North Side).
- Install Cycleway median separator on Mount Olympus Drive
- Start electrical upgrade works along Arncliffe Street.

Please note the new one way system is now in operation and it is a permanent traffic arrangement. Please follow all signs and directions given by traffic controllers.
